**Bus Departs M'ville HS at 4:00 AM** John Clarke and I will be driving

We will not be stopping for breakfast so you need to bring something to eat with you.

We make a lightning stop at a fast food/truck stop at about 8 AM

We are playing KC Lutheran EARLY...they have Prom...we'll try to start as close to 10AM as possible, plan on sleeping on the bus. We may look to do something with a father/son afterwards?? We'll head to the hotel following the game (Holiday Inn Sports Complex) around 2PM?? I am reserving rooms and **MUST** have reservations immediately. There are plenty of alternatives, so don't feel you need to use the Holiday Inn, but it is across the street from the Stadium. Water park tickets will be \$10 (the hotel has an indoor water park), but must be ordered now as well.

The **Holiday Inn Coco Key** is right on I-70 at the Stadium exit, directly across from the stadium. The exit is Blue Ridge Cutoff, exit 9, and is also the Stadium exit. The address is 9103 E. 39<sup>th</sup> Kansas City, MO phone: **816-737-0200**.

We are scheduled to play our game at 10:00 and will use either Avila University's field or Crysler Stadium. We will be the guests of Kansas City Lutheran, and were very fortunate they agreed to play. My other coaching contacts were involved in a conference tournament.

Following the varsity game we will return to the motel. The Royals are playing the Orioles and they open the gates at the end of the 7<sup>th</sup>. I will let the kids go over for the end of the game if they want, it's free and they can see the stadium in the evening. A brand new and large Bass Pro Shop is located just off Interstate 70, 6 miles east of the hotel...it is quite impressive. There are dozens of places to eat in this area. We will probably go with CiCis Pizza because it is cheap and fast, however there is plenty of choice. Denny's is within walking distance of the Hotel. For the more daring there are far better choices.

Sunday morning breakfast will be on your own, there is a restaurant at the hotel, and a Denny's nearby. We will eat an early lunch at Arthur Bryant's Barbeque in downtown KC (11:00), with the bus departing at 10:45. Players and stats will have to check out before we leave...parents will have more flexibility. Bryants will be around \$10. We will return to the hotel to park the bus and walk over to the Stadium for the Royals game which will begin at 1:00. I have reserved 45 tickets in the left field corner. Cost is \$31 and included \$15 of meal credit. I can get plenty more tickets, but I have to know now...if you want better/pricier tickets, indicate that with your order. We'll catch fast food on the way and should get back to M'ville at approximately 12:00.
